Once you have completed the *ORIENTATION: Ethical Behavior for the Addiction Professional* course, you will be eligible to make application to become designated as an **RADT (Registered Alcohol and Drug Technician) with CCAPP** or as a Substance Use Disorder Registered Counselor (SUDRC) with CADTP. This will allow you to start making application for positions in the drug/alcohol field. Be aware that many facilities may also want to see that you have 100 or more hours toward your basic education requirement to show your dedication to becoming credentialed.
